Based on analysis of the self-assessment results, Little Blue Research identified trends, challenges, opportunities and next steps for Ipieca to enhance the assessment and provide further nature related support for its members.

The challenge


- Agreeing a set of updated criteria for scoring the Nature Readiness Assessments.
- Engaging participating member companies to clarify their responses and ensure scoring was accurate and representitive.
- Consistently scoring assessments across all participating companies.
- Interpreting the WBCSD guidance on the completion of the Nature Readiness Assessments.





Outputs and results
